# Southern Shortened Scoring Descriptions 

## INFORMATION SHEET

In the event of inclement weather and/or other unforeseen circumstances, the Southern Championship Committee may go to a shortened format in order to allow matches to be completed on the court. This is not a method to rush matches but rather ensure that all team matches for all divisions get completed within a limited duration. You will find below descriptions of shortened formats that are likely to be used at a Southern Championship.

## DESCRIPTIONS

## No-Ad Scoring

At deuce (40-40), the winner of the next point wins the game. The receiver chooses which side the point is played. In Mixed Doubles at deuce ( $40-40$ ), the male player will serve to the male player, and the female player will serve to the female player.

## 8-Game Pro-Set

First to 8 games, win by 2 . For example, a winning match could be $8-1$ or $8-6$. If score is $7-7$, keep playing. A winning score can be $9-7$. If score is 8-8, a regular set tiebreaker is played (first to 7 , win by 2 ). The winning match score would be 9-8. Played with ad or no-ad (to be determined by Championship Committee).
10-game Pro-Set
First to 10 games, win by 2 . For example, a winning match could be $10-2$ or 10-8. If score is $9-9$, keep playing. A winning score can be 11-9. If score is 10-10, a regular set tiebreaker is played (first to 7 , win by 2). The winning match score would be 11-10. Played with ad or no-ad (to be determined by Championship Committee).

## Best 2-0f:3 Short Sets

Matches will be best $2-0 \mathrm{f}-3$ short sets with a match tiebreaker played in lieu of a 3rd short set. For each set, first to 4 games wins the set. Win by 2 . For example, a winning set could be $4-2$. If score in short set is 3-3, a regular set tiebreaker (first to 7 , win by 2) is played. The winning set would be 4-3. If each team win one short set, a match tiebreaker (first to 10, win by 2) is played to determine winner. The winning score could be 4-2, 1-4, 1-0(10-6). Played with ad or no-ad (to be determined by Championship Committee).

## ADDITIONAL NOTES

A conversion chart is located on the Southem Championship web site to determine how any shortened format converts to a best 2 -out-of -3 - set match. Any questions relating the shortened formats should be brought to the attention of the Championship Referee.
