**Captains' Meeting**

USTA Southern will require a completed "Captain's Checklist" in lieu of a captain's meeting. Successful completion of this form will be required as part of a team's eligibility to compete. A link to this checklist will be emailed to captains approximately seven days prior to the start of the championship.

Tournament staff will be available at Mobile Tennis Center from 5:00-6:00 PM CT on July 17, 2025. Please feel to come check out the tennis facility.

**Player Championship Items**

Beginning on Friday at 9:00 AM local time, players may come to the designated shirt station to pick up their championship shirt and bag tag. Players will pick these up individually, and captains will not be permitted to pick up items for the entire team. Each team's primary captain will also be given a captain's gift.

**What to Expect?**

- "Player Welcome Email" to be sent approximately 14 days prior to the start of the championship.
- Draws to be published a minimum of seven days prior to the start of the championship.
- A second "Player Welcome Email" to be sent approximately three days prior to the start of the championship.
- An update each morning from tournament staff (approximately one hour before matches begin).

- All communications will be done via Match Tennis Team App (“MTTA”). Please pay close attention to your email throughout the entire championship.
  - If you are not receiving communications through MTTA, please check your phone number and/or email listed on your profile in MTTA.
  - All communications for the tournament (or individual messages) can be viewed in a player’s “Inbox” located in MTTA.

There are no “reserved” practice facilities, so teams should plan ahead prior to coming to the championship.
