Deadlines

- \$55 Online Registration: May 19 – July 1, 2023, at 11:59 PM ET
- \$80 Late Online Registration: July 2, 2023, and after
- Registration Ends: July 20, 2023, at 11:59 PM ET
- Team must meet roster minimum (seven) and submit online team deposit by June 30, 2023, at 11:59 PM ET
- Individual Player requests for registration refunds will be honored if received by July 16, 2023. No refunds will be issued from July 17, 2023 and beyond.

Captains' Meeting

USTA Southern will hold an online captains' meeting. This will allow more time to travel to Auburn for the event. The online captains' meeting is required, and a captain should have another teammate in attendance if he/she is not able to attend. There will be two options for the captains' meeting: Tuesday, July 11, 2023, at 8 PM ET/7 PM CT, and Monday, July 17, 2023, at 2 PM ET/1 PM CT. A link for the meeting will be sent to captains in advance.

Tournament staff will be available at Yarbrough Tennis Center (Clay Courts Building) from 5-6 PM CT on July 20, 2023, for any captain who wants to pick up the team bag and/or ask any questions. For captains who do not pick up during this time, they may pick up their items prior to the start of their first scheduled match starting at 7 AM at the Yarbrough Tennis Center (Clay Courts Building).
