Deadlines

- \$55 Online Registration: January 15, 2024 – January 31, 2024, at 11:59 PM ET
- \$80 Late Online Registration: February 1, 2024, and after
- Registration Ends: February 29, 2024, 11:59 PM ET
- Team must meet roster minimum (three eligible pairings) and submit online team deposit by January 31, 2024, at 11:59 PM ET
- Individual Player requests for registration refunds will be honored if received by February 25, 2024. No refunds will be issued from February 26, 2024 and beyond.

Tournament Dates and Format

Southern will exhaust all attempts to finish the Southern Combo Doubles League Championship on Sunday. However, in the event of significant weather challenges, Sunday and/or Monday may be used to complete round robin, partial round robin and playoff matches, with play concluding as late as Monday. As part of these efforts all matches during the championship will be played with No-AD scoring.

Captains' Meeting

USTA Southern will hold an online captains' meeting. This will allow more time to travel to Lexington for the event. The online captains' meeting is required, and a captain should have another teammate in attendance if he/she is not able to attend. There will be one captains' meeting: Monday, February 12, 2024, at 9 PM ET/8 PM CT. A link for the meeting will be sent to captains in advance.

Tournament staff will be available at Cayce Tennis Center from 5-6 PM ET on February 29, 2024, for any captain/player who wants to pick up their player shirt and/or ask any questions. For anyone who do not pick up during this time, they may pick up their items prior to the start of their first scheduled match starting at 7 AM at the Cayce Tennis Center Only. **All players will pickup their own player shirts.**
